Permits are issued at the discretion of Boone County and requests for such permits reviewed with respect to type of vehicle, object to be moved, need, route, current pavement conditions, and possible damage to highway facilities. Permits are issued on an individual basis and do not constitute a precedent for the issuance of similar or subsequent permits. See page 2 for conditions.

CONDITIONS FOR OVERWEIGHT AND OVERSIZED VEHICLE PERMIT

1. The vehicle movement shall comply to the terms set forth in this permit, Boone County Code, the Illinois Department of Transportation's Manual on Oversized and Overweight Permit Movements and the Illinois Vehicle Code.
2. This permit applies only to the County highways listed on page 1. All highways marked within "()" are not the jurisdiction of Boone County and the applicant shall contact the proper agency for permission.
3. The permittee agrees to assume all responsibility for the injury or death to persons, and for damage to public or private property, including the vehicle and object being moved, whether owned by him/her or by others, caused directly or indirectly by the movement of object or objects authorized by this permit. The permittee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County of Boone, its agents, employees and representatives against any action for personal injury, death, or property damage sustained by reason of the execution of this permit.
4. This permit is not transferable and applies only to the applicant. This permit shall be carried in the vehicle during the movement.
5. Escort vehicles are necessary when required by the Illinois Department of Transportation's Manual on Oversize and Overweight Permit Movements, Section 554.407. Escort vehicles shall comply to Section 554.408. During certain situations law enforcement vehicles must be used in addition to civilian escorts. Boone County reserves the right to require escorts for safety as it deems fit.
6. No vehicle or combination of vehicles may be moved over a bridge or other elevated structure constituting part of the permitted highway if the gross weight of the vehicle is greater than the maximum weight capacity as signed on the structure, regardless of permit approval.
7. Due to climatic conditions or road surface deterioration, no vehicle or vehicles may be moved over a road surface if the gross weight of the vehicle(s) or the axle loadings exceeds the sign posted weight limits for that particular highway, regardless of permit approval.
8. The applicant shall be responsible to check the intended route for adequate horizontal and vertical clearance, road detours, construction, sign posted weight limits or any other factors that may affect the movement.
9. Vehicles shall abide by all applicable speed limits.
10. The vehicle movement shall only be made from one half hour before sunrise to one half hour after sunset on Mondays through Fridays and one half hour before sunrise to noon on Saturdays. Movements may not be made on Sundays or on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve Day after 3:00 PM, and Christmas Day.
11. Fees will be billed at the end of each month. If payment is not received within 14 days no permits shall be issued until payment is received.
