DRUG DEALERS IN BOONE COUNTY SENT TO PRISON

Boone County State's Attorney Michelle Courier announced that last week Dwayn Howard, 31, and Leonard Moss, 23, both from Chicago, were sentenced to serve time in the Illinois Department of Corrections for Class X felony drug charges.

Howard and Moss were both charged with the offense of Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Deliver to another 15 grams or more but less than 100 grams of a substance containing cocaine. The charges resulted from a traffic stop on Interstate 90, in which Howard was driving the vehicle and Moss was a passenger. Howard was sentenced to 6 years in prison, and Moss was sentenced to 7 years in prison. Moss had a prior felony drug conviction.
