Belvidere Man Sentenced to Prison for 11 years for Dealing Drugs

Boone County State's Attorney Michelle Courier announced today that Judge Fernando Engelsma sentenced Anthony Kendall, 42, of 321 E. Locust, Belvidere, to 11 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections after Kendall entered a plea of guilty to 2 counts of Unlawful Delivery of a Controlled Substance.

Kendall was convicted of delivering less than a gram of a substance containing heroin to a confidential informant on December 12, 2008, a class 2 felony, and 1.3 grams of a substance containing heroin to a confidential informant on January 7, 2009, a class 1 felony.

Kendall's prison term was extended beyond the maximum allowed for the Class 2 felony charge because of his extensive criminal history.
